- 150 hours total (100 pilot in command) (for CPL course)
- Medical test – class 1 in Spain
- Flight Skill test to determine candidate's level (School)

Remarks:

- Once passed the 14 official exams, the order to run the CPL or IR will depend on the student's flight hours.
- To run the CPL course, you must have 150 hrs. of which 100 hours at least must be of pilot in Command. Airmed will enable the planes to fly the required hours. Ask for a personal Hour building quotation.
- Flight hours: Flight Stage in CPL and IR will not start until the Civil Aviation official theoretical exams have been passed.
- The 14 official theoretical exams have to be passed in the 2 first settings. Otherwise the flight prices should be checked.
- The estimated length of flight stage is 5 months aprox.
- Books, Landing fees and exam fees not included.

Credits:

- If you 500 hours as CPL pilot, you have a credit of 10 flight hours in the CPL course.
- If you have more than 500 hours of instrumental flight, you have a credit of 50% of the Instrument rating course



Ground school Program

Option 1: Full time ATPL

The theoretical part consist in 650 hours during 8 months, where the students achieve the necessary knowledge for the official exams.

During this period, the student is in constant evaluation through exams and seminars held by the school.

Our fully qualified teaching staff is made up of working Pilots, Physicists and Aeronautical engineers, Meteorologists, Psychologists and Doctors.

Option 2: E-learning Modular ATPL course

AIRMED Flight School uses a modern WEB based e-learning service adapted to a JAR compliant learning material to conduct the Modular ATPL course.

The e-learning system gives a more flexible training environment to the students.

The school communicates with the student via different WEB based e-learning services. Student progression is monitored via online Progression Testing. The Instructors may also publish additional student material (text documents, images, animations WEB links and more) online, as desired.

By making student Progression Tests online, **AIRMED** gets the benefit of improved student progress monitoring and makes it easier to report student performance.

The estimated time to finish the distance learning program is 6 months. When the student completes the e-learning program, he is ready to come **one month** to Spain to received 75 ground school hours and take the final school and Civil Aviation exams, which are 14 in total.

JOB INTERVIEW SEMINAR (OPTIONAL)

In **Airmed** we care about our students' future.

In this seminar we help students in their job research process indicating what sources can consult to locate existing jobs in the labour market (employment agencies, professional schools, press, forums, etc).

The students will elaborate their own curriculum vitae deciding what model to use (chronological, functional, etc) based on their job experiences.

Also note that the medical has to be paid in advance by bank transfer and the bank receipt needs to be sent as well in advance by fax directly to the centre.

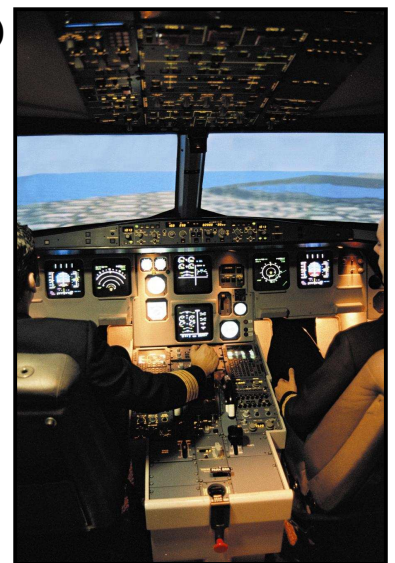
